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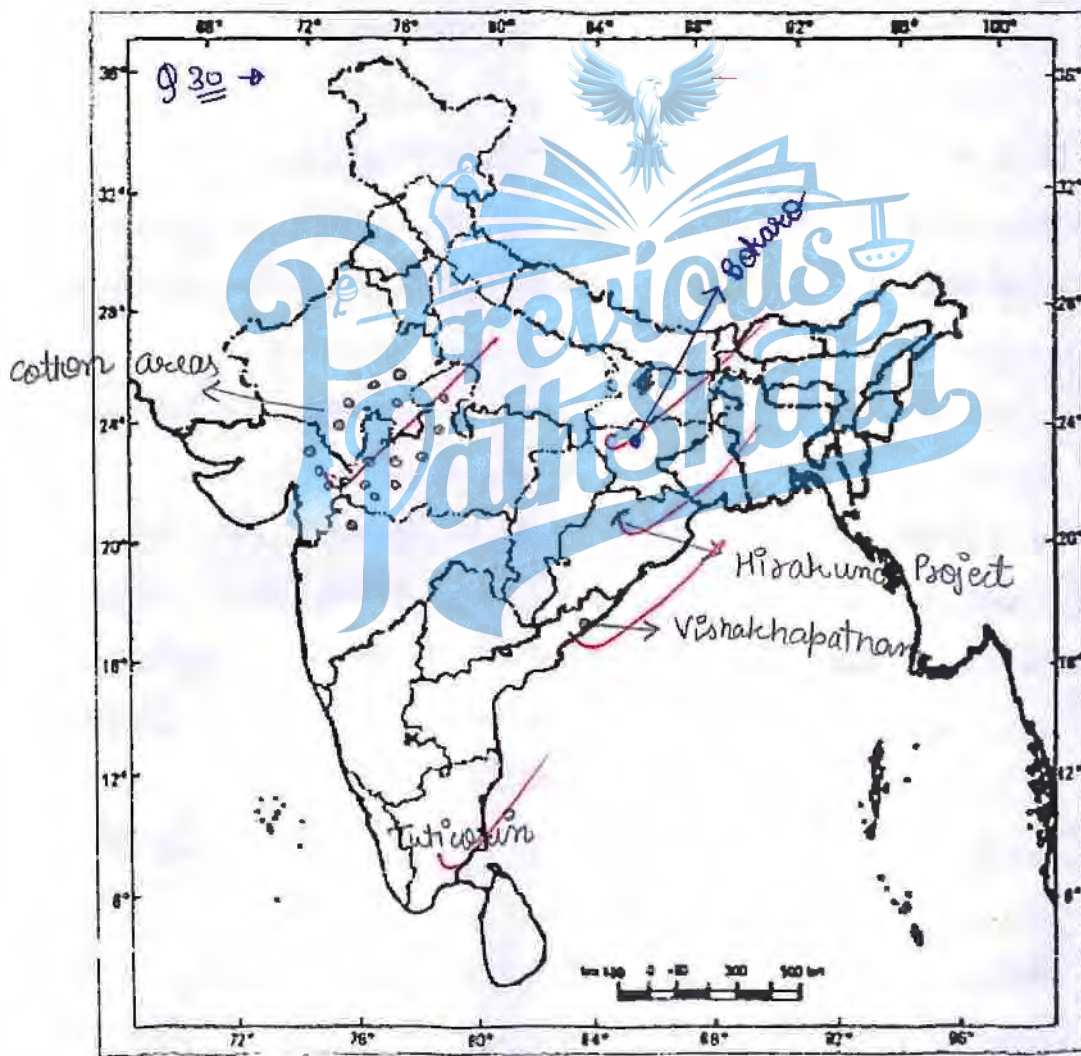

*. Belief in Constitutionalism -

'Democracy' protects our fundamental rights. Judiciary is independent in Democracy. It believes in written constitution. To make amendment, everyone has to follow a procedure in our constitution.

24) The economic reforms was adopted in decade 1990 are year 1991. The 3 economic reforms were liberalization, Privatization and Globalization.

⇒ Liberalization ▶

Under this economic reform, the government remove the state interference, licensing system before opening a industry, reduce taxes etc, increase trade with other countries etc.

⇒ Privatization ▶

It refers to changing the sector of industries from public to private sector. It involves the ownership of public or people also. It creates viability and self-reliance.

It refers to free flow of one's economy to ~~the~~ rest of the world. It includes ~~each~~ trade getting international currency, free flow of market etc. By this, the developing countries get the new technology from developed country. The production increases.

25) Barter System ▶

In ancient time, there was no development of plastic, metallic or other currency. Then barter system was used. In this system, the exchange of goods or services is done.

For example,

If a person is giving 50 kg wheat to the another person in exchange he has to give thing like 20 l milk or anything.

⇒ Disadvantages -

- * Double co-incidence
- * Delayed payment was not possible.
- * Measure of goods or services changes.

26) Legal rights of a consumer ▶

a) Right to get Information

*. The consumer should get each and every information about the goods or service which he/she is purchasing. Information like quantity, quality, weight etc.

b) Right to purchase at competitive prices

*. The consumer should get the material at stock prices. The producers sell their products at different prices. The consumer has the right to purchase that product which he desires and capable of purchasing it in order to price.

c) Right to complaint through various forums

*. The consumer can complaint through different forums made by the commission.

d) Right to be aware of various rights

*. The consumer should be aware of their rights. So that, their exploitation can't be done.

a) Sanyasi Rebellion -

The farmers were forced to grow indigo instead of having unfavourable conditions. The landlords were taken high taxes and land revenue from farmers. The Britishers put ban on the religious travel of the people. The farmers went on strike.

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b) Bhil Rebellion ▶

The farmers of Bhil tribe were forced to pay high taxes, land revenue etc. The landlords were ~~misbehaving~~ misbehaving with farmers. Baji Rao II and Trikhakaji Jangalia started a rebellion against them. It stopped due to some condition. But again started under the leadership of Seraram.

c) Shyamji Krishna Varma ▶

Shyamji Krishna Varma was the great revolutionary of India. After completing his education, he came to India and seen the corruption. He wanted to stop it. He established "Bharat Swastham Samiti" which is renowned as "India House" in London. He was the first to do the revolutionary practices or to establish house outside the country. The Britishers renewed about him and he ran away to Paris and continued it from there.

28) Powers of President ▶a) Executive Powers -

* He ~~can~~ appoints various officers like CJI, judges, Prime Minister etc.

* He is the supreme commander of our Indian



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		force. He can't use any force for his personal use. He can start or end any war after giving the written consent to Parliament.
		*. He sends <u>Ambassador</u> of our country to another country.
		*. All the <u>alliances or pacts</u> are done on the name of President.
		b) <u>Legislative Powers</u>
		*. He can dissolve call or postpone the meeting of Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha.
		*. He appoints 2 members of Lok Sabha of Anglo-Indian community and members of Rajya Sabha on the basis of art, music, literature, science etc.
		*. He ^{can} issues a <u>Ordinance</u> which is valid for 6 months.
		*. He can reject a proposal for one time and send it again for amendment but <u>second time</u> he/she is forced to sign on it with or without any amendment.

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29) Formation of State^{Legislative} Council* Number of Members

The number of state legislative council's member should be one third of the legislative assembly. But it should not be less than 40.

* Elections

The $\frac{5}{6}^{\text{th}}$ part is elected by the people and $\frac{1}{6}^{\text{th}}$ part is appointed by the president on the basis of art, science, literature etc.
