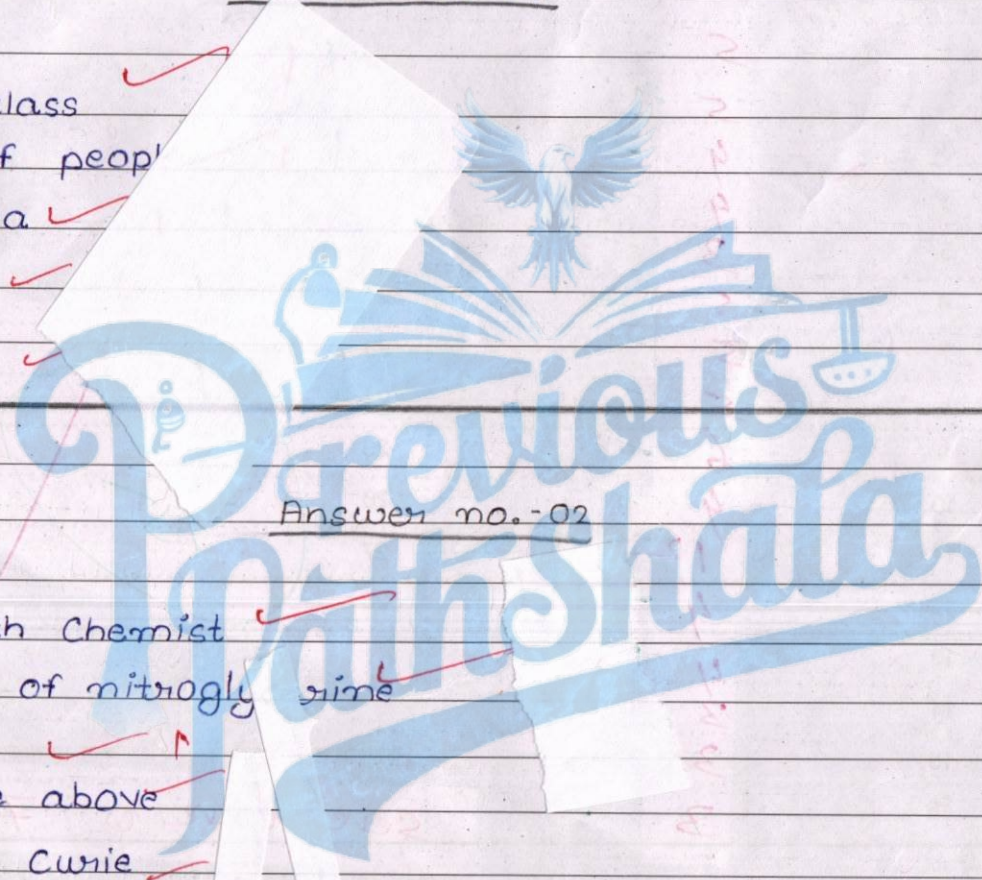

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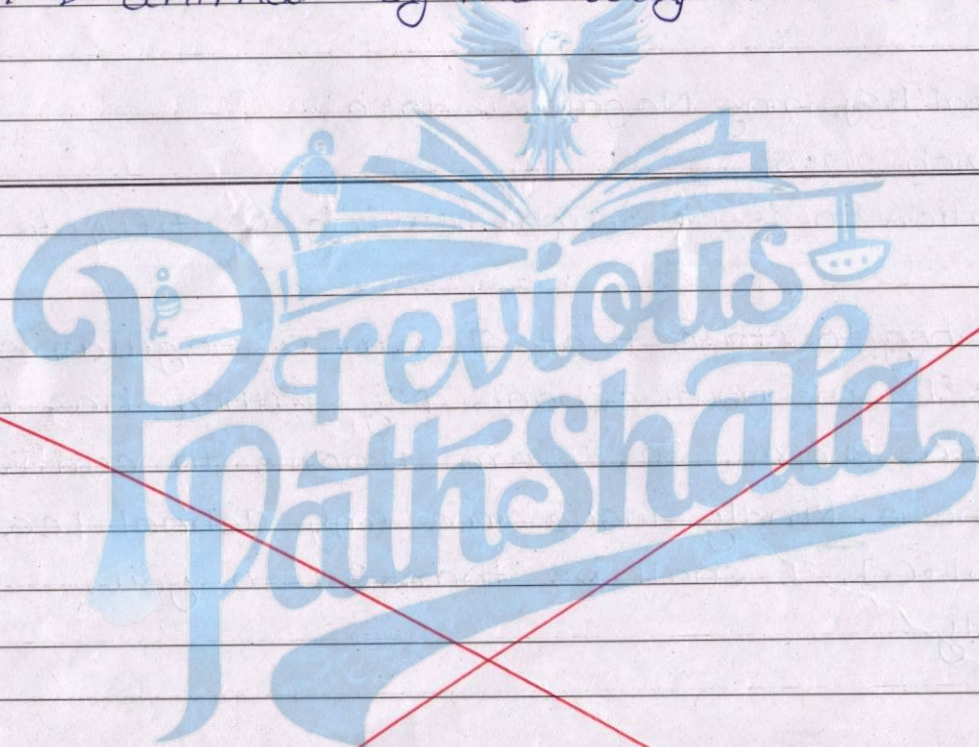


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but funny. According to her we can identify an animal by the way it kills.
